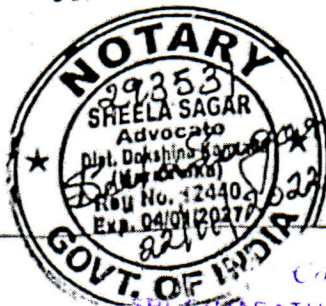

Conditions:

1. Under Right to Education 2009 or Karnataka Education Act 1983 and under the conditions followed by the above, the school was registered and recognition is renewed (Primary or High School 1 to 5th, 1 to 8th, 9th and 10th or 1 to 10th), Apart from these permission is not granted for any other class or section.
2. School should work under the provisions of the Act, Right to Education 2009 and Karnataka Education Act 1983.
3. Under the provisions of RTE Act of 2009, 25% of the seats should be reserved for economically backward students. The schools registered under RTE have the right to give the number of seats as mentioned by the Government under RTE. (Government has given provisions for the parents to admit their students in the neighboring schools and as per the provisions Government and aided schools have to give admission under RTE), If there are no such school's private schools have to admit such students and give opportunity for primary education. These students should be given provision to continue their education without any discrimination.
4. The Government will release the fees of children registered under RTE Rules as described in Annexure 3, therefore prohibiting collection of any fees from these children.
5. The school and the school management are prohibited from collecting any kind of capitation fee and voluntary donations from the parents either at the time of enrolment or thereafter.
6. Under the Karnataka Government Order No: ED 31PGC 2019 dated 27-07-2019 School or the management will publish the information about the tuition fees collected in the website and on the school notice board. The school should not collect any extra fees other than the mentioned.
7. School or management should follow the admission period as per the norms of the Government.
8. School or management cannot deny the admission for the following reasons

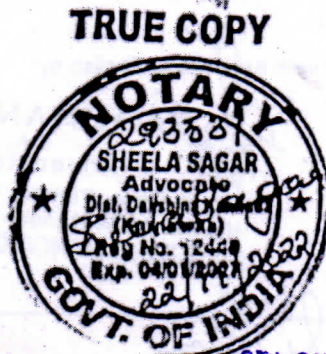

- a. Lack of age proof.
- b. On the basis of caste, religion, birth place and language.
- c. If the admission is sought after the normal admission period.
9. All safety measures have to be followed according to the provisions of RTE and Karnataka Education Act (the fire safety and building safety certificate has to be obtained also child education safety according to K.S.CP CR and N.C.P.C.R has to be followed).
10. School or management as per the following
 - a. Should not detain or given T.C to any child admitted in the school till the child completes the primary and High School education.
 - b. No child should be physically or mentally tortured in the school.
 - c. Any child is not expected to pass any board exam until it completes primary education.
 - d. Each child who has completed the primary education will get a certificate under the RTE Provision 21 and Karnataka Education Act.
 - e. Under the provision of Karnataka and RTE Education Act school should give admission to students with special ability or special children.
 - f. The teachers appointed in the school should have minimum qualification prescribed by the provisions of RTE and Karnataka Education Act.
 - g. School will follow the provisions of Karnataka Government for the salary and allowance and also for working conditions.
 - h. Teachers will work as per the section 24(1) and provisions of the RTE and provision 17 of Karnataka Education Act and will not take any private tuitions.
11. School will follow the syllabus and text books prescribed by the Education Department.
12. Admission of students should be according to the facilities available in the school as per the section 19 of Karnataka Education Act.
13. Appointment of staff and rules and regulations of the school should be as per Section 19.
14. unauthorized classes/sections can be opened outside the school
15. The school building and infrastructure should not be used for any commercial or political or any other non academic activities either day or night.
16. School should not be used for personal or for the benefit of any group of association.
17. The school has to be audited by a certified chartered accountant every year in the month of June and the audited report must be sent to the B.E.O or DDPI.
18. School will follow the Kannada Language Rule of 2016 for the language in the school.
19. The management and the teachers will work according to RTE Act and Karnataka Education Act.
20. The school and management will strictly follow the Rules and Regulations of the Government and the Department.
21. It is compulsory to update all the information of the school by the end of March in the SATS
22. If the above conditions are violated the recognition will be cancelled under the RTE Act of 2009 and Karnataka Education Act 1983.
